- \$2 will provide breakfast for a senior citizen or a healthy snack for a preschooler.
- \$3 teaches one child about living with disabilities through the “Count Me” In program.
- \$5 will allow a student with a disability to attend a career exploration tour, including lunch.
- \$5 provides the co-pay for a substance abuse therapy session.
- \$5 provides a County Connection ticket to take a resident to a doctor’s appointment.
- \$5 will provide a hot and healthy meal delivered to a home-bound senior.
- \$10 provides diapers for a young mother and her child.
- \$10 pays for one month of Project Livesaver for a child with autism.
- \$10 provides breakfast for a family staying in a domestic violence shelter.
- \$10 provides a spindle of DVD’s to record the forensic interview for an abused child.
- \$20 will provide a local teen with one day in an after-school program.
- \$20 will supply a new life jacket to keep a child safe while boating at camp.
- \$20 provides a gas card for a single mom to get to work.
- \$25 buys a warm coat and mittens for a child in need.
- \$25 will provide after-hours emergency notification to a community member serving in the military.
- \$30 will provide a day of licensed childcare for a toddler.
- \$30 provides one hour of smoking cessation counseling.

- \$50 provides a healthy after school snack for one Teaming Up with YOUth site.

- \$50 will pay for a group therapy session for someone struggling with drugs or alcohol.
- \$50 will provide life-sustaining oxygen for someone with no health insurance coverage.
- \$75 will pay for a counseling session for a depressed senior.
- \$75 provides five days of before- and after-school care for a young child.
- \$100 provides public transportation for one month for a disabled person to get to work.
- \$100 purchases two weeks worth of food for a family of four.
- \$100 provides program support for one volunteer Scout leader to impact 35 young men for a year.
- \$100 provides 500 pounds of free food to help feed families in need.
- \$115 will provide emergency groceries for victims of a house fire.
